

**ORDER**

Because appellant is represented by counsel in this appeal, we direct the clerk of this court to return, unfiled, the proper person documents received on March 14, 2016. "A party who is represented by counsel shall proceed through counsel and is not permitted to file written briefs or other papers, in pro se, with the exception of a motion to remove counsel." NRAP 46A(c). Further, appellant has no right to represent himself in this direct appeal. See *Martinez v. Court of Appeal of California*, 538 U.S. 152 (2000); *Blandino v. State*, 112 Nev. 352, 914 P.2d 624 (1996). Appellant should address all concerns regarding this appeal to counsel, and shall proceed through counsel in the prosecution of this appeal.
