MEMORANDUM

On June 18, 2015, Appellant Mazen Alotaibi filed a motion essentially

requesting a limited remand to the district court for an evidentiary hearing on

unspecified ineffective-assistance-of-counsel claims. For the following reasons,

the motion is opposed. First, Appellant's request does not, as he claims, serve

judicial economy. Just the opposite—as this Court is well aware, resolving habeas

petitions in the lower courts often takes years, leaving this appeal rotting on this

Court's docket the entire time. Second, proceeding in the manner Appellant

suggests would mean that any future petition raising ineffective assistance of

appellate counsel would be procedurally defaulted under NRS 34.810. Third,

Appellant's request is unnecessary—if, despite the aforementioned future default,

he wants to file a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus in the lower

court, nothing stops him from doing so.
