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This case arises from an anti-SLAPP litigation under NRS § 41.660. After Plaintiffs served Mr. Songer with the Complaint on July 4, 2014, Mr. Songer promptly moved to dismiss the matter based on Nevada's laws regarding strategic lawsuits against public participation ("SLAPP") on July 24, 2014. Nevada has a no tolerance policy for a SLAPP. Nevada provides complete immunity from civil liability for a good faith communication in furtherance of the right to free speech in direct connection with an issue of public concern.

The district court agreed, and granted Mr. Songer's Motion to Dismiss pursuant NRS § 41.660. As a result, Mr. Songer was entitled to reasonable costs and attorney's fees pursuant to NRS § 41.670(1). Mr. Songer argued that he was entitled to reasonable attorney's fees at the prevailing market rate, and not simply to the amount billed. The fact that Lipson Neilson negotiated rates in advance with the particular insurer involved in the matter, does not diminish the quality of the work and the fact that defense counsel ultimately prevailed. Mr. Songer requested an award of reasonable attorney's fees of \$32,885.50, which reflected the prevailing market rate for similar services in the Southern Nevada market. The district court only awarded the amounts billed.
