Re: Approval of ADKT 504

Dear Justices of the Nevada Supreme Court:

As a 24-year member of the Nevada Bar, I am writing in support of ADKT 504 - which would allow litigants to cite "unreported" Supreme Court dispositions.

Given the limited number of published decisions this Court renders every year, this rule change would be a positive development for litigators as it would result in more direction and refinement to Nevada jurisprudence and, thus, additional predictability for litigants and judges. As the Court is aware, the Ninth Circuit changed its rule in this regard many years ago, so ADKT 504 is simply a matter of "keeping up with the times." My only suggestion would be to eliminate the date restriction/prohibition against citing to older unreported dispositions.

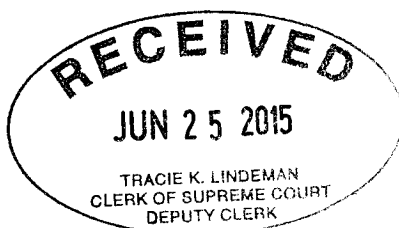
In sum, I would strongly encourage you to approve ADKT 504 as it is simply a matter of good practice.
