The State of Nevada, *ex rel.* Department of Taxation ("Department"), by and through its attorneys ADAM PAUL LAXALT, Attorney General of the State of Nevada, GINA C. SESSION, Chief Deputy Attorney General, and ANDREA NICHOLS, Senior Deputy Attorney General ("Respondent"); and Southern California Edison Company, by and through its attorney HALEY MCINTOSH ("Appellant") (the "Parties"), stipulate and agree to an extension of time for Respondent to file its Answering Brief, for the following reasons:

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
