First Request) on the grounds that Appellants "need additional time to submit an appeal, due to the inability to communicate with the clients, issues with available firm staff, etc." and "Appellants have also tendered a settlement offer and would like to explore that possibility rather than compelling the parties to carry through with the appellate process." Appellants requested a 90 day extension. 2015- 22340 at 1:23-27. Respondent, the Rogich Family Irrevocable Trust, did not object to Appellants' motion.

On August 14, 2015, the Court entered an Order Granting Motion which extended Appellants time to file and serving its opening brief and appendix until October 22, 2015. The Order provided that "[g]iven the length of the initial extension request, no further extensions shall be permitted absent extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B)." 2015-24654.

Appellants present motion was filed on October 21, 2015. It states that "Appellants need additional time to submit an appeal. Appellants are in the process of obtaining substitute counsel and would like the anticipated counsel to carry on with the case." It further states that "Counsel for Appellants intends to withdraw and Appellants are in the process of obtaining substitute counsel." 2015-32023 at 1:23-26, 2:7,8.

CONCLUSION

As there has been no showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need for granting Appellants an additional extension of time, the motion should be denied. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B), Order Granting Motion 2015-24654.
