DECLARATION OF DEBORAH L. WESTBROOK

- 1. I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada; I am a deputy public defender assigned to handle the appeal of this matter; I am familiar with the procedural history of this case.
- 2. On March 16, 2015, the Office of the Public Defender prematurely filed a Notice of Appeal in the instant case, after the District Court orally denied Mr. Grimes' motion to correct an illegal sentence, but *before* the District Court entered the final written order required by NRAP 4(b)(1)(A).
- 3. On March 19, 2015, the District Court ordered the Public Defender's Office withdrawn as counsel of record from Mr. Grimes' case due to the conflict of interest created by Mr. Grimes' Petition for Post-Conviction Relief.
- 4. On March 20, 2015, I filed a Motion to Withdraw as counsel in the instant appeal due to the conflict of interest created by Mr. Grimes' Petition for Post-Conviction Relief.
- 5. On March 24, 2015 the Nevada Supreme Court entered its Order re: Entry of Written Order and Suspending Briefing, stating "the district court retains jurisdiction" over the instant case until such time as a final written order is entered.
- 6. Because no final written order has **ever** been entered in this case that would transfer jurisdiction over the instant appeal to the Nevada Supreme

Court, jurisdiction remains with the District Court, which has already ordered the Office of the Clark County Public Defender withdrawn from Mr. Grimes' case.

- 7. Therefore, the Nevada Supreme Court lacked jurisdiction to issue its March 30, 2015 Order Denying Motion to Withdraw, which was filed after this Court agreed it did not yet have jurisdiction over the instant case, and after the District Court ordered the Office of the Public Defender withdrawn.
- 8. Accordingly, the March 30, 2015 Order Denying Motion to Withdraw should be stricken so that the District Court may appoint new counsel for both PCR and appellate purposes.
