Said sentence was suspended and the Defendant was placed on probation for 60 months under the standard terms and conditions of probation with the following special conditions:

- 1. The Defendant to obtain a substance abuse evaluation and if deemed necessary by the Division enter and complete a program at his own expense.
- 2. The Defendant to enter and successfully complete the Fourth Judicial Adult Drug Court Program.
- 3. The Defendant to abstain from the use of alcohol or being present in any establishment that serves alcohol unless required to be so present for employment.
- 4. The Defendant to abstain from gambling or being present in any gaming establishment unless required to be so present for employment.

Court adjourned.
