

*ORDER DIRECTING ANSWERS*

Having reviewed this original petition for a writ of mandamus, which challenges a district court order denying a motion to exonerate a bail bond and the forfeiture of that bond, we conclude that an answer will assist this court in resolving this matter. In light of the fact that real party in interest The State of Nevada did not oppose petitioners' motion to exonerate the bond, we direct both respondent the Honorable Janet J. Berry, District Judge, and the State to file and serve answers, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ within 30 days from the date of this order.
