The accident resulted in the death of Mrs. Trejo's husband, Rafael Trejo, who had been sitting in the passenger's seat. Following a two-week jury trial, the jury found the 2000 Ford Excursion's roof was defective in design, and the roof defect proximately caused Mr. Trejo's death. The jury awarded damages in the amount of \$4,500,000.00. The district court subsequently denied Ford's Renewed Motion for Judgment as a Matter of Law or, in the alternative, for New Trial, and awarded Mrs. Trejo \$ 356,703.51 in costs. Ford appeals.
- 11. **Previous appeal or writ proceeding:** This case has not previously been the subject of an appeal or an original writ proceeding in the Supreme Court or the Court of Appeals.
  - 12. **Child custody:** This appeal does not involve child custody or visitation.

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13. **Possibility of settlement:** The parties have discussed settlement post-verdict, and the possibility of settlement is unlikely.


