

*ORDER SUBMITTING FOR DECISION  
WITHOUT BRIEFING OR ORAL ARGUMENT*

This is an automatic review of a bar discipline matter pursuant to SCR 105(3). On April 30, 2015, this court issued a notice stating that the opening brief in this matter must be filed within 30 days and that if no opening brief was filed, the matter would be submitted for decision on the record without briefing or oral argument.
