*ORDER DIRECTING SERVICE OF CIVIL PROPER PERSON APPEAL
STATEMENT*

Having reviewed the civil proper person appeal statement filed by appellant, it appears that appellant has not properly served the document on respondent. See NRAP 25(b)-(d). More specifically, the certificate of service attached to appellant's civil proper person appeal statement is not properly completed, as appellant did not provide the names and addresses of counsel for respondents. See NRAP 25(d) (setting forth requirements for demonstrating proof of service). Accordingly, appellant shall have 15 days from the date of this order to properly serve the civil proper person appeal statement on counsel for respondents. Within that same time period, appellant shall file in this court a properly completed certificate of service that fully complies with NRAP 25(d).¹ Failure to comply may result in dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.

It is so ORDERED.
