JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE

On the 01st day of July, 2015, the above-named Defendant, STELLA LOUISE SINDELAR, [who is further described as follows: Date of Birth: September 26, 1963; (age 51); Place of Birth: Green River, Wyoming] was found guilty after jury trial to the crime described below and as more fully set forth in the Criminal Information filed herein. Legal counsel present at the Defendant's arraignment were, RICHARD W. SEARS, ESQ., White Pine County Public Defender, representing the Defendant, and ANGELA M. GIANOLI, ESQ., White Pine County Deputy District Attorney, representing the State.

DESCRIPTION OF CONVICTION

DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE, A FELONY AS DEFINED BY N.R.S. 484C.110; N.R.S. 484C.020; AND N.R.S. 484C.410.

On the 03rd day of September, 2015, the above-named Defendant appeared before this Court for the purpose of sentencing and entry of a final judgment of conviction in this

1 matter. This Court, the State and the Defense Counsel previously received a Pre-Sentence
2 Report prepared by the Division of Parole and Probation. The above-named Defendant
3 was personally present at the sentencing. Legal counsel present at the Defendant's
4 sentencing were RICHARD W. SEARS, ESQ., White Pine County Public Defender,
5 representing the Defendant, and ANGELA M. GIANOLI, ESQ., Deputy White Pine County
6 District Attorney, representing the State. Also present was STACY RICE, representing the
7 Division of Parole and Probation.

8 After hearing from all parties and allowing the Defendant an opportunity to
9 personally address the Court, this Court finds that the appropriate judgment in this case is
10 and shall be as follows:

11 SENTENCE TERMS

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13 For the conviction of DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE
14 INFLUENCE, the Defendant is sentenced to a maximum
15 term of seventy-five (75) months in the Nevada Department
16 of Corrections with a minimum parole eligibility of thirty
17 (30) months, with credit for time previously served in the
18 amount of five hundred eighty-three (583) days.

16 ENTRY OF JUDGMENT

17 **IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED** that the Defendant is guilty of said offense as
18 charged and convicted, and is sentenced to serve for DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE
19 INFLUENCE, the Defendant is sentenced to a maximum term of seventy-five (75) months
20 in the Nevada Department of Corrections with a minimum parole eligibility of thirty (30)
21 months, with credit for time previously served in the amount of five hundred eighty-three
22 (583) days.

23 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the Defendant shall submit to DNA
24 Analysis Testing to determine genetic markers.
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1 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the Defendant shall pay a One Hundred
2 Fifty Dollar (\$150.00) DNA Analysis Testing Fee to the White Pine County Clerk, Ely,
3 Nevada.

4 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the Defendant shall pay a Three Dollar
5 (\$3.00) Genetic Marker Analysis Administrative Assessment fee to the White Pine County
6 Clerk, Ely, Nevada.

7 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the Defendant shall pay a Sixty Dollar
8 (\$60.00) forensic fee to the White Pine County Clerk, Ely, Nevada.

9 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the Defendant shall pay a Twenty-Five
10 Dollar (\$25.00) administrative assessment fee to the White Pine County Clerk, Ely, Nevada.

11 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED AND THE COURT ADVISES**
12 **DEFENDANT** that pursuant to NRS 176.063, all administrative assessment fees, all other
13 fees, and all fines constitute a lien pursuant to NRS 176.275; and that should the Defendant
14 fail to satisfy said lien(s), collection efforts may be undertaken against the Defendant
15 pursuant to the laws of this State.
