Petitioner Western Cab Company moves the Court to consolidate Docket No. 68796 (Western Cab Company v. Eighth Judicial District Court (Laksiri Perera, real party in interest)) with Docket Nos. 66629 (Williams v. Eighth Judicial District Court (Claim Jumper Acquisition Company, LLC, real party in interest)) and 67631 (MDC Restaurants, LLC v. Eighth Judicial District Court (Paulette Diaz, real party in interest)).

This Motion is made on the grounds that each of these cases presents petitions for writs for mandamus seeking the Court's clarification as to what statute of limitations applies to claims for back minimum wage under the Minimum Wage Amendment, Nevada Constitution, Art. XV, Sec. 16.

The legal issue in these three petitions is identical and interrelated and the parties' and Court's resources will be conserved by consolidation, with duplication of efforts and energies reduced. *See Scarbo v. Eighth Judicial District Court*, 125 Nev. 118, 121, 206 P.3d 975, 977 (2009) (granting mandamus relief on consolidated petitions in the interest of "judicial economy and sound judicial administration" to clarify a criminal defendant's right in a competency proceeding to a full and complete copy of his or her competency examination report); *Oxbow Construction*, *LLC v. Eighth Judicial District Court*, 130 Nev. Adv. Op. 86, 335 P.3d 1234, 1238 (2014) (exercising discretion to consider consolidated petitions to resolve statutory remedies for construction defects applicable to new residences where definition of "new residences" lacked clarity); *Williams v. Eighth Judicial District Court*, 127

Nev. Adv. Op. 45, 262 P.3d 360 (2011) (consolidating writ petitions in product liability cases to resolve novel issues regarding admissibility of expert testimony); *Levinson v. Second Judicial District Court*, 103 Nev. 404, 742 P.3d 1042 (1987) (consolidating petitions for writ relief to clarify issues concerning enforcement of service of process on non-residents); *Sims v. Eighth Judicial District Court*, 125 Nev. 126, 132, 206 P.3d 980, 984 (2009) (considering consolidated writ petitions resolving necessity of independent competency evaluations in criminal proceedings).

The petitions present for clarification important and frequently reoccurring issues of law which have been resolved inconsistently among the State's District Courts and federal courts. Resolution of the statute of limitations applicable to back minimum wage claims is best presented by consolidating the writ petitions in Cases Nos. 66629 and 67631 with this case.
