*O R D E R*


This court previously entered an order directing appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Specifically, it appeared that the claims against Brian and Jennifer Ferguson remained pending in the district court such that the district court's order dismissing the complaint as to respondent was not a final judgment appealable under NRAP 3A(b)(1).

Appellant responded to our order on January 20, 2016, and indicated that a hearing regarding the entry of default judgments was scheduled for February 3, 2016. Although counsel stated that he would file a supplement to the response when the hearing took place and the district court entered an order, when almost a month elapsed with no communication from counsel, we ordered appellant to file and serve a supplement within 15 days.

Appellant filed the supplement on March 17, 2016. Therein, counsel states that he is awaiting the receipt of the default order entered by the district court. The district court docket entries indicate that the order was entered on March 18, 2016, and notice of entry of the order was filed on March 24, 2016. To date, however, appellant has not filed any further documents in this court.

Appellant shall have 5 days from the date of this order to file a supplement to the response to the order to show cause, including a copy of the district court order entering default judgments. Failure to file a supplement or otherwise demonstrate that this court has jurisdiction may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. Briefing and the preparation of transcripts remain suspended pending further order of this court.

It is so ORDERED.
