ORDER GRANTING MOTION

On October 1, 2001, appellant filed a motion requesting a second extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix. Good cause appearing, we grant appellant's motion. Appellant shall have to and including October 29, 2001, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix.

We admonish appellant's counsel, however, that the court disapproves of repeated requests for extensions of time to brief appeals in criminal cases. Consequently, no further extensions of time shall be permitted in the absence of extreme and unforeseeable circumstances. Counsel's caseload will not be deemed such a circumstance. See generally Varnum v. Grady, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974).
