ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY STAY AND DIRECTING ANSWER

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order directing that the issue of whether certain funds are exempt from execution must be decided in another state. Petitioner has filed an emergency motion to prohibit real party in interest Darrin Badger from withdrawing the funds at issue while the petition is pending. Having considered the motion, we conclude that a temporary injunction is warranted pending receipt and consideration of Badger's response to the motion. See NRAP 8(c), Fritz Hansen A/S v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 116 Nev. 650, 6 P.3d 982 (2000). Within 7 days from the date of this order, Badger shall file a response to the motion. We temporarily enjoin Badger from removing funds from the accounts at issue pending further order of this court.

Additionally, having considered the petition and reviewed the documents submitted with it, it appears that an answer to the petition will assist this court in resolving the matter. Therefore, real parties in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 30 days from the date of this order within which to file an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. Petitioner shall have 15 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.
