

ORDER DENYING INJUNCTION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order directing that the issue of whether certain funds are exempt from execution must be decided in another state. Petitioner has filed a motion to prohibit real party in interest Darrin Badger from withdrawing these funds while the petition is pending. This court temporarily enjoined Badger from removing the funds pending his filing of a response to the motion. Badger has now filed an opposition to the motion and petitioner has filed a reply. Having considered these pleadings, the documents before this court, and the relevant factors, we conclude that an injunction is not warranted. See NRAP 8(c); Fritz Hansen A/S v. Eighth Judicial Dist.
