**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus challenging a district court order in an action to enforce a domesticated judgment. In *Badger v. Eighth Judicial District Court*, 132 Nev., Adv. Op. 39, \_\_\_ P.3d \_\_\_ (2016), this court granted Badger's petition for writ of mandamus and directed the clerk of this court to issue a writ of mandamus instructing the district court to enter an order granting Badger's motion to dismiss and motion for summary judgment. Therefore, it appears that this petition is moot. This court's duty is "to decide actual controversies by a judgment which can be carried into effect, and not to give opinions upon moot questions . . . ." *NCAA v. University of Nevada*, 97 Nev. 56, 57, 624 P.2d 10, 10 (1981). Accordingly, counsel for appellant shall have twenty days

from the date of this order to show cause as to why this petition should not be dismissed as moot.

It is so ORDERED.
