TRANSCRIPT OF TRUSTEE'S OBJECTION TO DEBTOR'S CLAIM OF EXEMPTION FILED BY MICHAEL LEHNERS ON BEHALF OF ALLEN M. DUTRA [303] BEFORE THE HONORABLE GREGG W. ZIVE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT JUDGE

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THE COURT: In the matter of David Kaplan.

MR. LEHNERS: Good afternoon, Your Honor. Michael Lehners appearing on behalf of the trustee, Allen Dutra, who is also present.

MR. BURKE: Good afternoon, Your Honor. Christopher Burke for Mr. Kaplan for this matter only. He's present, also.

THE COURT: All right. There were filed on May 7th of this year an objection to the debtor's amended claim of exemptions. The objection is Docket Number 303.

There was a -- it says reply, but it's an opposition 12 that was filed by Mr. Burke on behalf of the debtor on June 13 23rd, Docket Number 311. I've read it, and I've read the 14 trustee's reply and response on Docket Number 313.

Have I read all the pleadings that have been filed in support of and in opposition to this motion?

MR. LEHNERS: Yes, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Mr. Burke, have I overlooked anything?

MR. BURKE: We have no other further pleadings that we've filed.

THE COURT: I'm sorry, I couldn't hear you.

MR. BURKE: No other further pleadings we've filed.

THE COURT: I have read an amendment cover sheet and amendment to Schedule C, property claim exempt, Docket Number 300, that was filed on May 5th of 2015 by the debtor. And I'll

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take judicial notice of that pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 201. This matter has been properly noticed and served as indicated in Dockets 304 and 305. It was originally set for hearing in the time $\operatorname{--}$ and that was changed pursuant to a notice dated July 2nd, Docket Number 314.

In addition to those pleadings, I have reviewed the minutes of a hearing that I conducted on May 5th, 2015, pursuant to a motion seeking to distribute proceeds and the issue of the amended claim of exemption was raised. exemption at issue is that found in NRS 21.090(1)(u) that reads as follows:

> "Payments, in an amount not to exceed \$16,150, received as compensation for personal injury, not including compensation for pain and suffer or actual pecuniary loss by the judgment debtor or by a person upon whom the debtor is dependent at the time the payment is received."

Prior to May 5th, 2015, in the original schedules 19 filed by the debtor, which were not amended regarding Schedule C when there were amended schedules filed and I think it was 2011. The only exemption for personal injury that the debtor sought was for \$16,150.

The amendment -- Docket Number 300, the amendment 24 doubled the claim exemption by seeking two exemptions under NRS $25 \mid 21.090(1)(u)$, both in the amount of 16,150 for a total of

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\$32,300. And that was discussed at the hearing of May 5th. And because it was the trustee's position that if the exemptions are allowed in the amount of 32,300, the case would be administratively insolvent and that, obviously, would have an effect upon the distribution of proceeds that the trustee had, including payment to Medicare that was still unresolved. Correct?

MR. LEHNERS: Yes, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Yeah. I noted at that time that I had been informed that there has been or would be an objection 11 filed to the claim of exemption. That has occurred. Since I 12 was aware of that fact, I did not allow payment in the event -in any event, pending a resolution in objection to your claim 14 of exemption.

Therefore, I did not allow any payments of any exempt 16 amount until the matter is resolved or until there was some type of consensual agreement. And I said it was protecting the estate by paying Medicare, so at least ones are preserved, that existed at that time, while being cognizant of the potential to enhance the value of the estate, based upon any claim you might have which now belongs to the trustee for overpayment from Medicare.

I ordered an objection to the amended exemption to be filed by the end of the week. It was filed I think two days after the hearing. I noted at that time that if the parties

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did not arrive at a settlement, that I would consider the objection, that I would do one of three things: Rule in favor of the trustee, or rule in favor of the debtor, or find that there was a unsettled question of Nevada law, certify the issue to the Nevada Supreme Court pursuant to Nevada Rule of Appellant Procedure 5 because the issue is solely and purely a matter of state law.

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It has nothing to do with the federal exemption because, as all parties recognize, Nevada has opted out pursuant to 522(d) of the federal exemptions. So I really am not persuaded one way or the other by any case that's interpreting the federal exemptions, whether that be a Connecticut bankruptcy court 21 years ago, as occurred in the Marcus case, a Texas bankruptcy court 12 years ago, In re Comeaux, or even the Eastern District of New York in the 16 Phillips case.

Even though I would say that I probably would agree 18 on a statutory interpretation of a statute that is not similar 19 to Nevada's statute, whether it was Marcus or Comeaux, but 20 understanding the reasoning of the Phillips case, I've read In re Christo and have read In re Rhodes, and I am familiar with Sutter because that opinion came from a ruling that this Court made. And I'm familiar, generally, with the law of exemptions.

I see no reason that I or a district court or the 25 Bankruptcy Appellant Panel for the Ninth Circuit should engage

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1 in an exercise in trying to determine how the Nevada Supreme Court would resolve this issue because applicable state law has not been determined by Nevada's highest court.

I know how I would resolve it, but I don't know if the Nevada Supreme Court would do that, and I don't hesitate to resolve it if I think it's fairly clear. And I would rule and sustain the objection based upon Nevada Rules of Statutory Construction. Nevada statute uses the word "payments," and that means any number of payments. It doesn't limit payments made sequentially for one injury. Maybe there could be the instant, whether it be a \$6,000 payment, then a \$10,000 payment, then a payment of \$150 for one injury, and in the aggregate they do not exceed 16,150, and if you look at the 14 rule of antecedent, that's what it refers to.

If you take a look at Rhodes where Judge Wedoff was 16 resolving an Illinois statute, the word was "payment," singular. Nevada has used the plural. So unlike Gene Wedoff, Judge Wedoff, I would not have to apply any exception to that rule.

So payments in an amount not to exceed 16,150. That not to exceed 16,150 in my mind clearly modifies the word "payments" received as compensation for personal injury. So 23 now we know the amount and we know the nature of the exemption, personal injury. It doesn't say personal injuries. It doesn't 25 indicate for more than one incident, two incidents, or ten

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incidents. It doesn't. It says you get a total of \$16,150 in payment for personal injury, and that those payments could be for one injury, two injuries, or any number of injuries. To me, it's relatively straightforward.

I understand, though, that there is a policy in Nevada with which I have absolutely no quarrel that exemptions are to be interpreted liberally because they are intended to provide a debtor with necessities of like a car, a home, for money from a personal injury, and any other exemptions contained in NRS 21.090.

> Citation was made to 21.090(f) which says: "Except as otherwise provided in Paragraph (p), one vehicle if the judgment debtor's equity does not exceed 15,000 or the credit is paid an amount equal to any excess above that equity."

And that was to make sure that the debtor had a vehicle to get to and from work, to be able to do whatever that person needed to do, but you only get one. And it isn't the 19 amount of equity. We clearly have a no-stacking rule. That's about it when it comes to numbers, and when you read all the others, you get one gun. That's NRS 21.090(i).

So if the legislature wanted to limit it to one incident, it could've done that, but it didn't. It's silent. 24 But it says, "Payments not in excess or not to exceed 16,150." 25 It uses the word "payments." And since it's not for pain and

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suffering or actual pecuniary loss, it has little to do with the public policy rationale that exemptions should be liberally construed. In other words, a car, a house, what, they're needed. They're a necessity.

Here it's 16,150 compensation for personal injury, not including compensation for pain and suffering. compensation for pain and suffering is not exempt. Actual pecuniary loss, it's not exempt. It strikes me that if one was real concerned about the necessity of life, you might want to exempt actual pecuniary loss. Because if that loss hadn't occurred, perhaps the debtor could have paid creditors and wouldn't had to file bankruptcy in the first place.

There is an exception for automobiles. It's found in (p), and that's 21.090(p), and it provides that:

> "Any vehicle owned by the judgment debtor for use by the judgment debtor, the judgment debtor's dependent that is equipped or modified to provide mobility for a person with a permanent disability."

In other words, a specific vehicle for a specific purpose, so you could have one vehicle that isn't modified and one that is. That's how I believe that's intended to be interpreted, so that's how I would find. But as I said, it might be better to send it to the Nevada Supreme Court, have it decide, only one Court of Appeal, the Nevada Supreme Court as 25 opposed to a decision from either the BAP or district court

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judge, and then a potential appeal to the Ninth Circuit.

So that's what I'm wrestling with. You have the burden, Mr. Lehners.

MR. LEHNERS: Your Honor, I agree with your analysis crystal clear, statutory construction. The noun is what's exempt; the modifier is not what's exempt. I couldn't agree with you more, and I believe that the burden has been met. So unless the Court has any questions of me, I don't want to risk --

THE COURT: But you do acknowledge that there is no interpretation of the statute by the Nevada Supreme Court, do you not?

MR. LEHNERS: No, nor need there be because the statute's clear on its face. Payments, plural, not to exceed \$16,150, a modifier as to amount for personal injury. Again, it's a modifier. It's the kind of payments that are exempt, not the modifier of injury itself. It would be like saying a green car is exempt up to \$15,000. The car's exempt, not the color green. So I do not believe that we need any aid in statutory construction or liberal construction or policy because those rules are rejected when the statute is clear on its face. Here, it is.

THE COURT: Thank you.

MR. LEHNERS: Thank you.

THE COURT: Mr. Burke.

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By the way, I should point out that when I read the Rhodes decision, there was one issue that was important to me because, when you read page 447 of that decision, the judge said there, and I'm quoting:

> "The trustee's reading of paragraph 84 limiting exemptions on account of personal injuries, the \$7,500 per debtor is not about the difficulty, but it is the best reading of the statute."

And, to quote, that statute, it does not mirror the language found in Nevada's exemption because it uses the word "payment" as opposed to "payments." It reads as follows:

> "That the law grants each debtor the right to exempt the debtor's right to receive, or property that is traceable to a payment, not to exceed \$7,500 in value, on account of personal bodily injury of the debtor or as an individual of whom the debtor was a dependent."

So there is a little -- there is that difference. And then when Judge Wcdoff was analyzing the last antecedent doctrine rule of page 447 of his opinion, he said that that would result in a statute that exempted any number of payments on account of a personal injury as long as these payments did not exceed 7,500.

And why did he say that? Because the last antecedent 25 doctrine meant that the "not to exceed 7,500" language modified

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24 25 the word "payment" as opposed to the \$16,150 figure in the Nevada statute that modifies the word "payments."

That is why I do not have to go through the exception that Judge Wedoff used where he found, however, the last antecedent doctrine has an exception, it is not to be applied when the intent of the legislators is (indiscernible) by the context in reading the entire statute requires a different reading. And I don't have to utilize that exception because the rule of the last antecedent doctrine is applicable here. just wanted to make that point.

He also, at page 446, found that the one exception in the Nevada and Illinois statute regarding a number was also in there, motor vehicle exemption which only allowed one motor vehicle. He found there was no language in numerical limitation in paragraph (a) (4):

> "Accordingly, the phase on account of personal bodily injury again must be seen as defining the nature of the payment that is exempt and not the number of the injuries."

And I concur with that analysis. I just wanted to make that clear.

Go ahead, Mr. Burke.

MR. BURKE: Well, I don't think the statute is clear on its face. Let me just read, it says: "Received as compensation for personal injury."



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If it had said "received this compensation for a personal injury," that maybe would lend more towards what the trustee's saying. But I think it is ambiguous and we're only dealing with 16,000. And instead of going through appeals at the BAP and the Ninth Circuit and the like, I would ask and agree with the Court's initial view that this should go to the Nevada Supreme Court.

THE COURT: And based upon my tentative ruling, if you said anything else, I'd be fairly surprised. And I agree with you. I'm going to ask counsel to certify this question, prepare the certification, submit it to me for certification to the Nevada Supreme Court.

MR. LEHNERS: Your Honor, before we close the hearing on this, could I talk to Mr. Burke for about five minutes?

THE COURT: Sure. I'll be glad to --

MR. BURKE: Your Honor, there are two other issues, though, that I would like to bring up. In the first personal injury --

THE COURT: The dog?

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MR. BURKE: Right. In this situation, Mr. Kaplan's been kicked out of his house.

THE COURT: My rule is still in place. Talk to Mr. Lehners. I'll come back in about ten minutes.

MR. BURKE: Okay.

THE CLERK: All rise.

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(Recess taken at 2:28 p.m.)

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(Proceedings resumed at 2:40 p.m.)

THE COURT: Take your seat. Yes, sir.

MR. LEHNERS: Your Honor, I'm sorry. We were unable to come to any arrangements.

THE COURT: All right.

MR. LEHNERS: So it looks like it will be certified.

THE COURT: Then certify the questions in the Nevada Supreme Court as to whether the exemption provided by NRS 10 21.090(1)(u) was intended to apply to more than one incident and whether it is \$16,150 cap on all payments received from any 12 number of incidents. Try to write it with a little more clarity than that, submit it to me with the certification and these other forms. You've done it before. Submit it to me and we'll send it over to the Supreme Court.

And I'm going to authorize the payment of \$16,150 to 17 Mr. Kaplan because, as noted by the trustee, the dispute is 18 only over a double claimed exemption and there's no dispute 19 regarding \$16,150. I see no reason for Mr. Kaplan not to 20 receive that amount.

MR. LEHNERS: Your Honor, I believe the amount would 22 be -- I'll check the accounting, but Mr. Burke was paid \$2,000, 23 and I believe it would only be 14 --

THE COURT: So it would be \$14,150.

MR. LEHNERS: Yes.

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1 THE COURT: I remember, that's exactly what we did because Mr. Kaplan went on the record saying he approved the 3 payment from his exempt funds to Mr. Burke. 4 Correct, Mr. Kaplan? 5 MR. KAPLAN: That is correct, Your Honor. It is 14,000. 6 7 THE COURT: So the 14,150 would I believe --8 MR. KAPLAN: The balance. THE COURT: -- would be the correct amount. 9 10 MR. KAPLAN: That is the balance of the money. 11 THE COURT: Anything else? 12 MR. BURKE: No. 13 THE COURT: Is that it? 14 MR. BURKE: Did you want me to do the order? Is that what you said, Judge? 15 16 THE COURT: I think you should confer with 17 Mr. Lehners to make sure that the language is correct. there's any question about that, contact my chambers and we'll 18 19 resolve it. 20 MR. ORDER CERTIFYING QUESTION OF LAW TO THE NEVADA SUPREME COURT

1. Question of Law Certified:

DEBTOR(s)

This Court requires clarification as to whether a debtor may exempt a personal injury claim for each separate personal injury incident. The Chapter 7 Trustee, Allen Dutra, ("Mr. Dutra") argues that a bankrupt debtor may only exempt one personal injury claim, even if he was involved in more than one personal injury incident.

The Debtor, David John Kaplan, ("Mr. Kaplan"), argues that pursuant to NRS 21.090(1)(u), he may exempt a separate personal injury claim for each separate and distinct personal injury he suffers.

Pursuant to NRAP 5, THE BANKRUPTCY COURT respectfully certifies the following question of law to the Nevada Supreme Court:

If a debtor has more than one separate personal injury incident, is he entitled to more than one personal injury exemption?

2. Factual Background

Kaplan, in *pro per*, filed a Chapter 11 bankruptcy (Case No. 10-54568-GWZ) on November 19, 2010. That case was converted to chapter 7 on September 5, 2012 (Dkt. 60). Prior to that, Kaplan was involved in two personal injury cases. One, on March 18, 2009, where he was involved in a dog attack and hurt his back (Rivera matter). The second personal injury, occurred when Kaplan was rear-ended on May 4, 2010 and he hurt his lower back (Connell matter).

The Debtor initially had exempted one personal injury. Then on May 5, 2015, Debtor amended his schedules to include the second exemption for his second personal injury [Dkt. 300]. On May 7, 2015, the Trustee filed an Objection to Debtor's claim of Exemptions [Dkt. 303], asserting Debtor is only entitled to one personal injury exemption.

This Court did not rule on whether Mr. Kaplan is entitled to a second personal injury exemption for the second personal injury incident.

3. Designation of Parties:

This Court will designate, Debtor, David John Kaplan as the appellant, and Chapter 7 Trustee, Allen Dutra as the respondent.

TRUSTEE'S RESPONSE TO DEBTOR'S

REPLY TO OBJECTION TO EXEMPTION

COMES NOW Chapter Seven Trustee, Allen Dutra, by and through his attorney, Michael Lehners, Esq. and files the following Trustee's Response to Debtor's Reply to Objection to Exemption.

1. Issues Raised by Debtor

The Debtor was involved in two accidents that were unrelated. He seeks to double Nevada's personal injury exemption as a result. The Debtor's argument recites the well known rule that exemptions are to be liberally construed in favor of the Debtor. However, when a statute is as clear as a glass slipper and fits without strain, courts should not approve an interpretation that requires a shoehorn. *Demko and Penn Arms, Inc. v. United States* 216 F.3d 1049, 1053 (C.A. Fed. Cir. 2000). The Debtor's argument shatters the slipper.

NRS 21.090(1)(u) exempts payments, in an amount, not to exceed \$16,150.00, for personal injury. In matters of statutory construction, the first step is to

determine whether the language has a plain and unambiguous meaning with regard to the particular dispute. *Hawkins v. Franchise Tax Bd. of California*, 769 F.3d 662, (9th Cir. 2014). The dispute focuses on the term "personal injury".

Black's Law Dictionary defines the term as "a hurt or damage done to a man's person, such as a cut or bruise, a broken limb or the like, as distinguished from an injury to his property or his reputation". Black's 5th Ed.

Mr. Kaplan was damaged in each accident. Each damage would be an injury. NRS 21.090(1)(u) uses the singular "personal injury" and the plural "payments". For that reason, the exemption is based upon multiple payments for bodily injury. It does not make the injuries divisible nor are the payments linked to the events that caused the injury.

Mr. Kaplan cites NRS 21.090(1)(f) because it uses the term "one vehicle". Mr. Kaplan claims this language shows that the Legislature knew how to limit an exemption to one. It is equally reasonable to presume the Legislature knows the difference between plural and singular nouns and the adjectives that modify them.

In conclusion, Mr. Kaplan was hurt in two separate events. NRS 21.090(1)(u) gives him an exemption for his injury, singular. The statute is silent on the cause of the injury. The glass slipper will fit the \$16,150.00, not the \$32,300.00 sought by the Debtor.

262728	Kaplan filed his Chap	oter 11 bank	kruptcy (Case No. 10-54568-0	JWZ) on November			

19, 2010. That case was converted to chapter 7 on September 5, 2012 (Dkt. 60). Prior to that, he was involved in two personal injury cases. One, on March 18, 2009, where Kaplan was involved in a dog attack and hurt his back (Rivera matter). The second personal injury occurred, when Kaplan was rear-ended on May 4, 2010 and he hurt his lower back (Connell matter). Six weeks prior to the second injury, Kaplan had back surgery. The second accident hampered his recovery from the back surgery. Kaplan then had to have a second back surgery in July 2011.

Kaplan, who is on social security disability, has a plethora of health problems, including diabetes and osteoporosis. In addition he takes care of his twenty-six year old disabled son (Ex. "A" Decl. Of Kaplan").

Originally, Kaplan exempted only one of his personal injury claims on Schedule C which was filed on December 22, 2010. (Dkt. 21). Kaplan amended Schedule C of his bankruptcy on May 5, 2015 to include two different personal injury exemptions, i.e. \$16,150 for personal injury settlement stemming from a dog attack (Kaplan vs. River) and another \$16,150 exemption stemming from an auto accident (Kaplan vs. Connell). (Dkt. 300).

Chapter 7 Trustee, Allen Dutra, filed an Objection to Debtor's Claim of Exemptions on May 7, 2015 [Dkt. 303]

III ARGUMENT

1. Bankruptcy debtor's in Nevada are entitled to the state exemptions

Upon the filing of a bankruptcy petition, an estate is created consisting of all legal and equitable interests of the debtor in property as of the date of the filing of the petition. 11 U.S.C. §541(a)(1). In return, Section 522(d) allows a debtor to exempt certain property from his or her estate, protecting it from creditors. But the Bankruptcy Code provides an opt-out provision whereby a state can either require the debtor to exempt property under the state law exemptions or grant the debtor the option of choosing

between state and federal exemptions. See 11 U.S.C. §522(b)(2). Nevada is an opt-out state. E.g., *In re Kane*, 366 B.R. 477, 489 (Bankr.D.Nev. 2006). See NRS §21.090(3). In bankruptcy actions, the validity of a claimed state exemption is controlled by the applicable state law. *In re Goldman*, 70 F.3d 1028, 1029 (9th Cir. 1995). A bankruptcy court is bound by the state's rules of construction when interpreting a state statute. *Id*. Therefore, Nevada law governs the substantive issues regarding this exemption.

2. Exemptions are liberally construed

Exemptions are to be liberally construed in favor of the debtor who claims the exemption. *In re Arrol*, 170 F.3d 934, 937 (9th Cir. 1999); *In re Christensen*, 122 Nev. 1309, 1312 (Nev. 2006) ("We liberally and beneficially construe our state exemption statutes in favor of the debtor."). "The purpose of Nevada's exemption statutes is 'to secure to the debtor the necessary means of gaining a livelihood.'" *Savage v. Pierson*, 123 Nev. 86, 90 (2007) (quoting *Kreig v. Fellows*, 21 Nev. 307, 310 (1892)). If a statutory phase is left undefined, the court construes the phase, according to its plain and ordinary meaning. *In re Resort at Summerlin Lit.*, 122Nev. 177, 180 (2006). The courts general presume that the plain meaning of the words reflect the legislature's intent, unless the reading violates the spirit of the act or leads to an absurd result. *Villanueva v. State*, 117 Nev. 664, 667 (2001).

3. The burden in objecting to Kaplan's exemption is on the Trustee

A claim of exemption is presumed valid, and the burden is on the objecting party, i.e. the Trustee in this case, to prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an exemption is improperly claimed. *In re Nicholson*, 435 B.R. 622, 634 (9th Cir. BAP 2010); Fed.R. Bankr.P. 4003©. When a decision turns upon applicable state law and the state's highest court has not decided the issue, a federal court must use its best judgment to ascertain how the state court would decide that issue. *General Motors Corp. v. Doupnik*, 1 F.3d 862, 865 (9th Cir. 1993). The court may also be aided by

looking to well-reasoned decisions from other jurisdictions. *Takahashi v. Loomis Armored Car Service*, 625 F.2d 314, 316, (9th Cir. 1980).

The court must interpret a statue consistent with the intent of the legislature, must ascribe an intent which will accomplish a reasonable result, and must resolve any doubt as to legislative intent so as to avoid an absurd result. *Steward v. Steward*, 11 Nev. 295, 302 (1995). A statute may be interpreted by considering the reason or spirit of the law, the causes which induced the legislature to enact it, and the entire subject matter and policy for the law. *Cragun v. Nevada Pub. Employees' Ret. Bd.*, 92 Nev. 202, 205 (1976). When interpreting a statutory provision, Nevada courts look first to the plain language of the statute, and ascribe words their plain meanings. *Savage v. Pierson*, 123 Nev. 86,88 (2007).

4. Kaplan's personal injury exemptions are valid

In this case, the Nevada Revised Statutes provide: "payments in an amount not to exceed \$16,150, received as compensation for personal injury . . . by the judgment debtor." NRS 21.090(1)(u). Here, Kaplan seeks to exempt \$16,150 from two separate personal injury claims under NRS 21.090(1)(u). Clearly, one of these claims is exempt. However, the Trustee is objecting to Kaplan's second personal injury claim of exemption.

A. Nevada law would allow both personal injury exemptions

Ironically, the answer to the question of whether a debtor can exempt two separate personal injury claims, can actually be found within NRS 21.090. A look at NRS 21.090(1)(f), specifically allows a debtor to exempt *one* vehicle, not to exceed \$15,000 in value. Thus, the Nevada legislature knew how to limit an exemption to one, if it desired to do so. Here, in relation to personal injury claims, it did not do that. While the Nevada legislature has specifically included a qualifier in NRS21.090(1)(f), such an exclusion is absent from N.R.S. § 21.090(1)(u). "It is a basic tenet of statutory

construction that if the legislature includes a qualification in one statute, but omits the qualification in another related statute, it should be inferred that the omission was intentional." In re Norris 203 BR 463, 467 (Bankr. NV 1996), citing, see also Ex Parte Arascada, 44 Nev. 30, 35, (1990) (the failure of a statute to include a matter is an indication that exclusion was intended)." The often quoted maxim of statutory interpretation, expressio unius est exclusio alterius, tells us that when a legislature "includes particular language in one section of a statute . . . it is generally presumed that [the legislature] acts intentionally and purposely in the disparate inclusion or exclusion." Russello v. United States, 464 U.S. 16, 23 (1983).

"It is assumed that the provisions of *N.R.S § 21.090*, the statutory scheme for exemptions, were carefully drafted; they are a result of a legislative drafting process which began in 1911 and they have been the subject of numerous legislative revisions since that time. Based upon this premise, this Court will not supply a statutory provision when it is reasonable to suppose the Legislature intended to omit it." *Id* at 467. Arguably, Nevada's statute, like the federal one, is not plain but is ambiguous as to whether it exempts more than one personal injury. However, the key is that it can be reconciled within itself. Therefore, Kaplan can protect \$16,150 from each personal injury. ¹

B. The majority cases under the federal exemption agree with Kaplan

To the extent, this Court seeks guidance on this issue from the few cases under the involving the federal exemptions, the majority favor Kaplan by a four to two margin. Three involve the exemptions under 11 USC §522(d)(11) or (12). For instance, in the case of *In re Marcus*, 172 BR 502 (Bankr. D.Conn. 1994), a debtor was allowed to

Kaplan has yet to use his wildcard, so at least \$1,000 of his second personal injury claim is exempt.

exempt both of his personal injuries. See also, *In re Comeaux*, 305 BR 802 (Bankr.E.D. Tex. 2003); *In re Daly*, 344 BR 304 (Bankr. M.D. Penn. 2005). The other case that is in accord with the debtor's position is *In re Anderson* 932 P.2d 1110 (Okla. 1997) (state law).

There is one circuit level case that has opined on this issue and favors the Trustee. See *In re Christo*, 192 F.3d 36 (1st Cir. 1999). However, it is the dissent in *Christo* that makes the most cogent argument. It noted, that the majority relied on *In re Rhodes*, 147 BR 443 (Bankr. N.D. Ill. 1992) in rendering its decision. But the dissent in *Rhodes* was based upon a number of erroneous assumptions. For instance, "*Rhodes* also referred to the fact that the statutory list of exemptions distinguishes between exempted and unexempted property by its nature and not number. . . [But] this proves little, however, as those subparagraphs in the federal statute enumerating property which may be aggregated list either groupings of types of property such as household furnishings, . . ., or certain enumerated property interest in life insurance contracts . . ." *Christo* at 40 (dissent).

The Trustee's brief also makes some questionable arguments. For instance, the Trustee's reference to 11 USC §102(7) is misplaced. Why? Because in Nevada debtors' exemptions are determined under state law. Thus §102(7) would not apply. But to the extend it applies to the federal exemptions under §522, it could have possibly had an effect on the *Marcus*, *Comeaux* and *Daley* cases, but did not. Because even with §102(7) being available, those cases still correctly allowed the debtor multiple personal injury exemptions. And the logic in those cases make perfect sense. For instance, as one case stated, it would be entirely rational "if a debtor lost one limb in one accident and another limb in another accident, the debtor should not be limited to one exemption." *Marcus* at 505.

5.

Judicial estoppel should not apply

Kaplan should not be estopped from amending his exemptions. The law is clear, a debtor may amend his exemptions as a matter of right at anytime before a case is closed. Fed.R.Bankr. P. 1009. *In re Michael* 163 F.3d 526 (9th Cir. 1998). Here, although a few years into the case, Kaplan amended his schedules prior to the Trustee's distribution of proceeds. Thus, there is no prejudice to the Trustee. Besides, an individual can amend their exemptions up to the time a case is closed.

Here, the Trustee mischaracterizes the event. Kaplan did not take opposing positions. Kaplan merely added to his allowed exemptions. I would ask the Court to keep in mind, that Kaplan has been representing himself, and that he is a sixty-six year old man who is on social security disability with cognitive impairment from a car accident, diabetes and osteoporosis. See (Exhibit "A" - Declr. of D. Kaplan, ¶6 -7). In addition, he is taking care of his mentally disabled son. See (Exhibit "A" - Declr. of D. Kaplan ¶8).

IV

CONCLUSION

Exemptions are to be liberally construed. The legislature knows how to limit an exemption to one item when it wants to. Here, it chose not to limit the number of personal injury exemptions. Therefore, this Court should not put itself in place of the legislature and unneccessarily limit Kaplan's exemption.

COMES NOW Chapter Seven Trustee, Allen Dutra, by and through his attorney, Michael Lehners, Esq. and files the following Objection to Mr. Kaplan's amended Schedule "C". Specifically, Mr. Kaplan originally claimed an exemption of \$16,150.00. He now seeks to exempt an additional \$16,150.00 because he was involved in two accidents.

Background

The two accidents are unrelated. Each case settled. Mr. Kaplan claimed an initial exemption under NRS 21.090(1)(u) which exempts:

Payments, in an amount not to exceed \$16,150, received as compensation for <u>personal injury</u>, not including compensation for pain and suffering or actual pecuniary loss, by the judgment debtor or by a person upon whom the judgment debtor is dependent at the time the payment is received.

Emphasis supplied

Mr. Kaplan claimed an exemption for \$16.150.00 in his initial schedules that were filed on December 23, 2010 (DE 21). He later amended his schedules on August 9, 2011, but he did not change the amount of his exemption. See DE 41.

On March 19, 2015 the Trustee filed an amended motion for interim distribution (DE 277). The amended motion was served upon the Debtor. On April 16, 2015 the Trustee a second amended motion (DE 283) containing the same information that was noticed to the creditor matrix. The Debtor was served with this motion as well. Both motions sought to pay the Debtor his \$16,150.00 personal injury exemption. The hearing was set for May 5, 2015. On that day, the Debtor amended Schedule "C" to claim \$32,300.00 under NRS 21.090(1)(u) on the basis that he was involved in two accidents.

The Trustee is only objecting to the amounts in excess of \$16,150.00.

2. Argument

Nevada's statute uses the words "personal injury". Injury is singular. Injuries is plural. It is clear that the exemption is based upon bodily injury, not the event or events that caused the injury. Statutes must be read to give meaning to all of their parts and language, and courts are to read each sentence, phrase, and word to render it meaningful within the context of the purpose of the legislation. *Harris Associates v. Clark County School Dist.*, 119 Nev. 638, 81 P.3d 532, (Nev. 2003).

In Suter v. Goedert, 396 B.R. 535, (D. Nev. 2008) the Court noted that Nevada exempts from the bankruptcy estate payments received as compensation for personal injury. Id at 543. The Court went on to note

that the phrase "personal injury" in general refers to any harm caused to a person, such as a broken bone, a cut, or a bruise. Id at 544, citing authorities.

Put another way, "payments" is the plural of "payment". The use of the plural envisions more than one settlement and more than one event. The term "payments" is modified by the phrase "in an amount not to exceed \$16,150". It does not matter how many times the Debtor is injured, because the aggregate payments are capped at \$16,150.

In re Rhodes 147 B.R. 443 (Bkrtcy N.D. Illinois 1992) is noteworthy because it involved a state exemption for personal injury proceeds in a bankruptcy court.

Paragraph (h)(4) of the Illinois law grants each debtor the right to exempt "[t]he debtor's right to receive, or property that is traceable to, ... a payment, not to exceed \$7500 in value, on account of personal bodily injury of the debtor or an individual of whom the debtor was a dependent." Id at 445.

As in this case, Mr. Rhodes claimed multiple \$7,500.00 exemptions for multiple accidents.

The Court denied the exemption. It employed four cannons of statutory construction.

- 1. The consideration of the entire statute,
- 2. The last antecedent doctrine,
- 3. The presumption for statutory consistency and
- 4. The presumption against absurdity and injustice.

The Court found the plain language of the paragraph did not support the Debtor's interpretation. What is exempted is the debtor's

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right to receive, or property that is traceable to a payment on account of personal bodily injury. This language plainly exempts (1) the debtor's right to receive payment of a particular type and (2) property that is traceable to such a payment. The nature of the payment is specified by the phrase "on account of personal bodily injury." Paragraph (h)(4) contains no language relating to the number of personal injuries. Accordingly, the statutory language, on its face, offers no support for an exemption that varies in amount depending on the number of personal injuries affecting a debtor. Id at 446.

The Court found the statutory scheme favored the Trustee. Like Nevada's scheme, the exempted property in nearly every paragraph of the statute is distinguished from nonexempt property only by its nature. not by its number. Id at 446.

The Court found the Debtor's interpretation to be absurd and unjust because it would unfairly discriminate against debtors who had the same injuries but different events that caused them.

The Court said the debtors' reading requires disparate treatment for similarly situated debtors. If one person has suffered injuries compensable to the extent of \$75,000 arising out of a single incident, the debtors' reading of the statute would provide an exemption of \$7,500 to that person. Yet if another person has suffered precisely the same injuries, arising equally out of ten separate incidents, then the debtors' reading of the statute would provide an exemption of \$75,000. The number of incidents, however, has no bearing whatever on the debtor's need for funds. Id at 447.

The Trustee had argued the last antecedent doctrine requires the phrase "not to exceed \$7,500" modify the word "payment". The Court

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found the reading of the entire statute indicates that the limitation of \$7,500 relates to the "right to receive property or property that is traceable to" any payment on account of personal bodily injury, thus supporting the trustee's reading.

Nevada has adopted the same principles of statutory construction.

1. Nevada Tax Com'n v. Bernhard, 100 Nev. 348, 683 P.2d 21, (Nev. 1984). In determining the meaning of a specific provision of an act, the act should be read as a whole.

- 2. J.E. Dunn Northwest, Inc. v. Corus Const. Venture, LLC, 127 Nev. Adv. Op. 5, 249 P.3d 501, (Nev. 2011). Recognizing the last antecedent rule of statutory construction.
- 3. Orr Ditch & Water Co. v. Justice Court of Reno Tp., Washoe County. 64 Nev. 138, 178 P.2d 558, (Nev. 1947). The spirit of the statute will prevail over the strict letter.
- 4. Sheriff, Clark County v. Burcham, 198 P.3d 326, 124 Nev. 1247. (Nev. 2008). Statutory construction should always avoid an absurd result.

These rules should be applied in the same fashion to NRS 21.090(1)(u) so that only the aggregate of \$16,150.00 is allowed.

3. The Federal Exemption

11 U.S.C. §522(d)(11) exempts: The debtor's right to receive, or property that is traceable to a payment, not to exceed \$22,975, on account of personal bodily injury, not including pain and suffering or compensation for actual pecuniary loss, of the debtor or an individual of whom the debtor is a dependent.

The cases are split on on whether or not multiple accidents authorize exempting more than the \$22,975 statutory cap.

For example, Collier on Bankruptcy ¶ 522.09[11] (15th ed. rev.1998) goes on to state that if the debtor has sustained injuries in separate accidents, he or she may claim an exemption for the injuries suffered in each accident. Following this logic, it would appear that the debtor could make separate claims for exemption for each injury suffered in a single accident, citing In re Marcus, 172 B.R. 502 (Bankr. D. Conn.1994). See also In re Comeaux, 305 B.R. 802, (Bankr. E.D. Tex. 2003), which reached the same conclusion as Marcus.

These cases are at odds with the holding of *In re Phillips* 485 B.R. 53 (E.D.N.Y. 2012). That Court held only \$21,625 was available to the Debtor who had been in two accidents.

Phillips is the better reasoned decision because the Bankruptcy Code has one rule of Statutory Construction that Nevada does not have. II U.S.C. §102 sets forth the rules of statutory construction that are to be used with the Code. II U.S.C. §102(7) says "the singular includes the plural". Thus, §522(d)(11)(D)'s term "a payment" encompasses both a singular payment as well as multiple payments, and the term "injury" includes multiple injuries. Given this rule of construction, §522(d)(11)(D) should be read as "a payment [or payments], not to exceed \$21,625, on account of personal bodily injury [or injuries]." The grammatical structure of §522(d)(11)(D), therefore, requires the monetary cap "not to exceed \$21,625" to apply with equal force to either one or multiple payment(s) and regardless of how many injuries the debtor suffered. Phillips at 57.

In Marcus, the debtor claimed two personal injury exemptions, both for the then statutory maximum of \$7,500. See Marcus, 172 B.R. at 503. In Comeaux, the debtors claimed three separate personal injury

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exemptions. Both courts held that a debtor may claim multiple exemptions under \$522(d)(11)(D), each up to the statutory maximum, for payments on account of personal bodily injuries arising from distinct incidents.

The Comeaux court based its conclusion on the following: 1) the general rule of construction that exemption statutes are to be construed liberally in favor of a debtor; 2) Congress demonstrated its ability to utilize numeric and aggregate limits elsewhere in \$522 and did not do so in \$522(d)(11)(D); and 3) as a policy matter, debtors who suffer personal bodily injuries from multiple incidents should be afforded the small degree of financial protection the personal injury exemption affords.

The *Phillips* Court disagreed with the reasoning of both courts since the statute was plain on its face when applying the rule set forth in 11 U.S.C. §102(7). Id 56-57.

While *Phillips* is squarely in the Trustee's favor, it is no more relevant to the analysis than *Marcus* or *Comeaux*.

NRS 21.090(1) is unlike \$522(d). First, it does not use the term "aggregate" for some exemptions but not for others. Second, there is no Nevada statute that parallels 11 U.S.C. \$102(7).

For this reason, it is a simple matter of statutory construction, and any case interpreting §522(d)(11) is inapplicable.

4. Judicial Estoppel

The application of judicial estoppel bars the assertion of inconsistent positions in the same litigation. *Hamilton v. State Farm Fire & Cas. Co.*, 270 F.3d 778, (9th Cir. 2001). In this case, the Debtor's \$16,150.00 exemption was allowed 30 days after he field his schedules. They were filed on December 23, 2010. He reaffirmed the \$16,150.00

exemption on August 9, 2011. He was served with all of the pleadings that settled the two cases and participated in those cases. He was served with the Trustee's motions for interim distribution that clarified only \$16,150.00 was to be paid. Yet on the day of the hearing, the Debtor amends his schedules to add an additional exemption of \$16,150.00. supposedly upon the advice of some "Mystery Lawyer" that he refused to identify!

If the additional exemption is allowed, the estate will be administratively insolvent. This means the lawyers who worked to bring in the assets will have to write a check to Mr. Kaplan for his last minute strategy. That is not fair, nor is it equitable.

For those reasons, the exemption must be allowed in the amount of \$16,150.00.
