

ORDER SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

The district court entered the judgment of conviction on January 22, 2016. We conclude that we have jurisdiction over this appeal. See NRAP 4(b)(2); NRS 177.015(3). Briefing shall proceed pursuant to NRAP 3C.

Appellant shall have 11 days from the date of this order to file and serve 2 file-stamped copies of the rough draft transcript request form and proof of service of the rough draft transcript request form or a certificate stating that no transcripts are being requested. See NRAP 3C(d)(3)(A), (D). Appellant shall have 50 days from the date of this order to file and serve the fast track statement and appendix. See NRAP 3C(e)(1), (2). We caution appellant's counsel that failure to comply may result in the imposition of sanctions. See NRAP 3C(n).
