

*ORDER DENYING MOTION*

The parties have filed a stipulation to extend the time to file the opening brief in this appeal to correspond to the briefing schedules of a related appeal and petition for writ of mandamus that have not yet been filed in this court. We treat the stipulation as a joint motion. See NRAP 31(b)(2).

Granting the instant motion would lead to a delay of at least 120 days in the briefing of this appeal. We are not convinced that such a lengthy delay is warranted, especially given that the related appeal and original writ petition have not yet been filed in this court. Accordingly, the motion is denied.
