I am an attorney duly licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada, and the

Chief Deputy Special Public Defender assigned to handle Mr. Collins direct appeal

from his jury trial. Pursuant to the Order of this Court, the Opening Brief and

Appendix are due May 16, 2016.

Submitted herewith is the Opening Brief which is 17,545 words. The word

limit for non capital cases is 14,000 words, and Appellant is requesting to be allowed

to file his Opening Brief with 17,545 words based on the reasons set forth

hereinbelow.

This appeal presents several issues of a constitutional magnitude following a

lengthy jury trial. The Appellant challenges the sufficiency of the evidence for both

offenses, requiring a full and complete recitation of the evidence presented at trial.

In addition, there is one issue of first impression in Nevada and another which has not been squarely addressed, requiring a more in-depth discussion of the law than what might otherwise be necessary.
