

ORDER REQUESTING THE FILING OF BRIEF OF AMICUS CURIAE

This court has determined that a brief from the Family Law Section of the State Bar of Nevada would assist in resolving this matter. In particular, this court requests the Family Law Section to address whether this court should provide a standard for courts to use in determining child support obligations for situations in which a parent has primary physical custody of at least one child and shared custody of at least one child. Should the Family Law Section consent to participate as amicus curiae, this court requests that the Section file and serve its amicus brief within 21 days of the date of this order. If an amicus brief is filed and served, appellant and respondent may file and serve any response to the brief within 20 days from the date that the amicus brief is served.
