MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR APPELLANT TO FILE OPENING BRIEF

Appellant Nationstar Mortgage, LLC requests an additional thirty (30) days to file its opening brief in this matter. This is Nationstar's second request for an extension of this deadline.

Appellant's opening brief was originally due on April 21, 2016. Pursuant to a stipulation between the parties, that deadline was extended to May 23, 2016. Nationstar requests an additional thirty (30) days including and until **June 22, 2016** to file its opening brief.

There are good grounds to grant this motion. This appeal involves a number of substantial issues of first impression, which may affect hundreds of similar cases currently pending in the State of Nevada. Additionally, the appendix will be lengthy, with dozens of district court documents consisting of several hundred pages, many of which need to be analyzed and presented in the opening brief. Counsel has been

1 diligently working on the brief, but counsel requests the additional 30 days to ensure
2 the brief as filed presents arguments that are as thorough and organized as possible.
3 The request is not made lightly or for the purpose of delay. The additional time
4 requested is necessary to finalize an appropriate opening brief for this court's
5 consideration. Appellant has confirmed with opposing counsel that they do not
6 oppose this motion.
