*ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR STAY*

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenging a district court order denying in part petitioner's motion to dismiss in an action relating to the Minimum Wage Amendment. Petitioner has filed a motion for stay pending resolution of its petition.<sup>1</sup> Real parties in interest oppose the motion and petitioner has filed a reply. Having considered these documents as well as the relevant factors, we grant the motion. *See* NRAP 8(c); *Fritz Hansen A/S v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 116 Nev. 650, 657, 6 P.3d 982, 986 (2000). 


