A party is not obliged to use all of the time allowed, and the court may terminate the argument whenever in its judgment further argument is unnecessary.

The issue in this case involves the interpretation of the federal statute, 12 U.S.C. §1467 and its numerous sub-parts. It is respectfully submitted that 30 minutes per side would be a more appropriate time to present the positions of the parties in this matter.
