10 believes that additional time is necessary for the adequate presentation
11 of his or her argument, counsel may request such additional time as he
12 or she deems necessary. A motion to allow longer argument must be
filed reasonably in advance of the date fixed for the argument and shall
be liberally granted if cause therefor is shown. A party is not obliged to
use all of the time allowed, and the court may terminate the argument
whenever in its judgment further argument is unnecessary.

13 The issue in this case involves the interpretation of the federal statute, 12
14 U.S.C. §1467 and its numerous sub-parts. It is respectfully submitted that 30 minutes
15 per side would be a more appropriate time to present the positions of the parties in
16 this matter.
