I'm glad we met in Las Vegas to discuss recent developments at Nuveda. As noted, unless a complete, timely resolution is reached that effectively removes the company from potential regulatory issues that could result in penalties and the loss of license(s), 4Front's preliminary proposal to provide \$3.5 million of capital for the development of both dispensaries will be cancelled.

We discussed various structures for your legal team to evaluate. One structure for consideration is for Nuveda Holdings to issue note in exchange for all equity interests from two of the founders.

- Repayment of the Nuveda Holdings note would be from proceeds of current fund raising initiative and from Nuveda's share of profits from dispensary operations
- All the assets, including both dispensary licenses, of Clark NMSD, LLC will be ring-fenced from Nuveda Holdings and all of its existing and future entities

4Front is committed to facilitating Nuveda's success. However, the longer matters are unresolved, the greater the likelihood that Nuveda's value will diminish. For this reason and unless a satisfactory resolution is reached, 4Front's preliminary proposal will terminate Wednesday, November 18, 2015 at 5 p.m. MST.
