**REPLY TO EMERGENCY  
MOTION UNDER NRAP 27(e) FOR

**[IMMEDIATE RELIEF  
REQUESTED]**

21 Real Party in Interest Steven C. Jacobs' ("Jacobs") reiterates his request that  
22 this Court enforce its order denying Petitioners' request for a stay and clarifying its  
23 Order Setting Oral Argument. Contrary to Petitioners' claims, the District Court did  
24 not unilaterally decline to take action. It is Petitioners who renewed their improper  
25 enlistment of NRS 1.235(5) and then asserted that this Court's denial of their  
26 Motion for Stay had no impact or consequences because this Court had not really  
27 considered anything in issuing that denial. The effect of the Petitioners' improper  
28 maneuvering is to subvert this Court's Order and claim a partial stay. This has been  
confirmed by the District Court's vacating of yet another round of motions,  
including a motion to compel filed by Jacobs which was set to be heard today. (Ex.  
1 hereto, Minute Order). Once again, these delays materially impact Jacobs' ability  
to prepare this case for the long-awaited trial date of June 27, 2016. These delays

materially prejudice Jacobs' rights, on a case that the Petitioners have delayed for nearly six years. *Foster v. Dingwall*, 126 Nev. 56, 227 P.3d 1042 (2010) (Prejudice is presumed from delay of right to discovery).

Petitioners' continuing reference to NRS 1.235(5) in order to freeze the District Court from ruling on any matters is flatly improper. This Court has held that NRS 1.235 is inapplicable to any judge who has ruled on contested matters in the case. *Towbin Dodge, LLC v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct.*, 121 Nev. 251, 256, 112 P.3d 1063, 1067-68 (2005). Otherwise, parties seeking to procure delay, like these Petitioners, could simply file untimely affidavits and enlist NRS 1.235(5) to procure delay. Respectfully, if this Court tolerates these Petitioners' tactics, it will effectively empower any litigant to stall a case indefinitely, even though their motion for disqualification has been denied and a stay refused by both the Chief District Court Judge and this Court.
