Appellants' opening brief and appendix were originally due on August 8, 2017. This Court previously granted two extensions of time totaling 44 days, making Appellants' opening brief and appendix currently due on September 21, 2017. If this Court grants this request for an extension of 5 judicial days, Appellants' opening brief will be due on September 28, 2017. Good cause exists for allowing Appellants to extend the filing deadline until September 28, 2017:

Mr. Echols was brought into another case on an emergency basis on Monday evening, September 18, 2017, to draft a writ petition, which had to be filed in this Court by 11 a.m. on Tuesday, September 19, 2017 (docketed as Case No. 74001, LVMPD v. Dist. Ct.). This required Mr. Echols to draft throughout the night to meet such a demanding deadline and necessarily caused a delay in completing the opening brief in the instant case. In the underlying case (Eighth Judicial District Court Case No. C-16-318635-1, State of Nevada v. David Frostick), the District Court Judge has ordered a temporary stay of the jury trial but is requiring that a motion be filed in this Court on an emergency basis to expedite the decision on the writ petition in order to keep the stay in place, which has caused another delay in the completion of Appellants' opening brief.

Appellants have filed their appendix, and the opening brief is nearly complete. The additional 5 judicial days will allow time for the brief to be

completed, sent to the client and co-counsel for review, and for any requested revisions to be made.

Therefore, Appellants respectfully request that the deadline to file their opening brief be extended by 5 judicial days to September 28, 2017. This motion is submitted in good faith and for good cause shown in accordance with NRAP 31(b).
