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This Court finds that a party who prevails in an action is entitled to move for its costs. See Nev. Rev. Stat. 18,020. Here, having prevailed at the conclusion of a jury trial, Plaintiff is a prevailing party and is entitled to statutory costs per NRS 18,005 and 18,020. Having reviewed the Memorandum of Costs and accompanying documentation on file, and having evaluated the requested costs in light of *Berosini v. PETA*, 114 Nev. 1348 (1998), the Court **HEREBY ORDERS** that utilizing the eight categories in Plaintiff's memorandum of costs, costs will be awarded in full as requested for the following categories of costs:

Category (1) In House Expenses (which includes copies, postage, courier and long distance costs) - \$5,026.53;

Category (3) Expert Fees - \$69,975.95. The Court specifically finds that all named experts were necessary to Plaintiff's case, and exceeding the statutory amounts is justified and reasonable for Dr. Yoo and Dr. Cash based on their roles in the litigation;

Category (4) Express Mail - \$172.31;

Category (5) Investigation/Service - \$528.48;

Category (6) Medical/Financial Records - \$2,055.90; and

Category (8) Travel Expenses - \$488.00.

Regarding Category (2) Deposition Expenses, the Court finds that the TrialSmith charge of \$868.00 and the Turner Reporting charge of \$372.25 are unjustified and the total amount awarded for that category will be \$4,679.75.

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Regarding Category (7) Misc. - Upon review of the papers and pleadings on file herein, the Court notes that plaintiff, after prevailing at trial, has moved for an award of attorney s fees. The sole legal basis stated in plaintiff s request is NRS 18.010(2)(b). Pursuant to NRS 18.010(2)(b), attorney s fees are awardable to the prevailing party when the court finds the opposing party s claims were brought without reasonable grounds or to harass the prevailing party. Moreover, the court is to liberally construe the provisions of 18.010(2)(b). Plaintiff has alleged that all and/or at least the liability part, of defendant s defenses were maintained without reasonable grounds and therefore plaintiff should be awarded its appropriate attorney s fees. As with most, if not all, medical malpractice actions, issues regarding liability and damages are separate. Even when one issue or the other is agreed upon between the parties, evidence regarding each issue requires a different presentation to the jury. Generally speaking, where both issues are contested, the liability portion requires much more time and effort as you never even reach the issue of damages without first establishing liability. This case was no different. Although certain witnesses addressed both issues, the manner of the presentation on each issue is different and the time spent on presenting each issue is different. Understanding this is important in the instant case because the court cannot find that defendant s liability defense was maintained with reasonable grounds, although defending the issue of damages was made in good faith and with reasonable grounds. The presentation of evidence on liability, which it should be noted

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included evidence and opinions from some of defendant s own experts, was overwhelming. It could not only be characterized as clearly exceeding the civil burden of proof standard but, arguably, the totality of evidence showing that the original surgery was performed at the wrong level of the spine would meet a beyond a reasonable doubt standard. Turning to the issue of time, it is difficult to ascertain with precision exactly how much time and effort is spent on liability issues versus damages issues over the course of a jury trial, particularly one such as this that spans the course of three weeks. However, a review of available information allows the Court to conclude that it is reasonable to characterize the presentation of liability issues (though jury selection, opening statements, evidence presentation and argument) as encompassing at least 80% of plaintiff s trial presentation. The Court has further evaluated the requested amounts, the documentation provided and, pursuant to Schouweiler, 101 Nev. 827 (1985), has taken into account the complexity of the case, the quality of the advocacy, the character of the work, the work actually performed and the results. The Court also finds that the application of NRS 7.095 is an appropriate mechanism to address attorney s fees. Based upon that, the Court finds that the total attorney s fees award of \$212,486.98 as requested in plaintiff s reply brief (which is less than the original amount requested in the motion) is an appropriate figure to which to apply the 80% designation described above. Therefore, having found pursuant to NRS 18.010(2)(b) that defendant maintained a liability defense without reasonable grounds and that plaintiff s liability presentation at trial encompassed at least 80% of their time and effort, the Court now ORDERS that attorney s fees will be awarded in the amount of \$169,989.58.
