RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DISQUALIFY JUDGE

LINDA MARQUIS

COMES NOW, Judge Linda Marquis, and submits her response to Defendant Lyudmyla A. Abid's Motion to Disqualify the Honorable Linda Marquis filed on April 06, 2018.

Ms. Abid alleges the Court "can't give fair litigation" because the Court was protecting Plaintiff and Plaintiff's Counsel and as a result entered orders that are biased against Defendant. *See* Ms. Abid's Motion to Disqualify the Honorable Linda Marquis.

This matter came on for Evidentiary Hearing on the 11th and 25th of January 2016, and was thereafter appealed to the Nevada Supreme Court.

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The Court made an evidentiary ruling regarding audio recordings. Counsel for Ms. Abid argued that the audio recordings should not be admitted into evidence and, in fact, the audio recordings and/or transcripts were never admitted into evidence. However, the Court allowed Plaintiff's expert, Dr. Stephanie Holland, to review the audio tapes and/or transcripts of the audio tapes, along with other things that were not admitted into evidence, prior to her interviews of the Parties and the Parties' minor child.

The Court did not delay the hearing of this matter. Ms. Abid's Counsel requested a continuance of the Evidentiary Hearing, which was granted. *See* Defendant's Motion to Continue Evidentiary Hearing, filed July 31, 2015. Later, Counsel for both Parties stipulated to continue the Evidentiary Hearing. *See* Stipulation and Order dated October 1, 2015.

On December 07, 2017, the Nevada Supreme Court issued a unanimous Advanced Opinion in this matter affirming this Court's orders. The Nevada Supreme Court stated that this Court's factual findings in this matter were support its determination as to the child's best interest. Therefore, this Court did not abuse its discretion in providing recording to the expert as it aided the Court in its determination as to the child's best interest.

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The Court maintains no personal bias or prejudice concerning a party or a party's lawyer in this matter. Further, the Court has no personal knowledge of facts that are in dispute in this matter.
