NRAP 44 NOTICE OF CONSTITUTIONAL ISSUES

Pursuant to NRAP 44 and NRS 30.130, appellant notifies the clerk of this Court and the Attorney General of Nevada, Adam P. Laxalt, that this appeal concerns the constitutionality of NRS 425.3844(3)(a). That statute mandates the automatic entry of child-support masters' recommendations as judicial decrees, eliminating the district court's power of review unless one of the parties files an objection.

This notice is filed as a precaution because although the Clark County District Attorney initiated the district-court proceedings, neither the state nor any subdivision was formally named as a petitioner.
