



ORDER GRANTING MOTION



Cause appearing, the motion of the Family Support Division of the Clark County, Nevada, District Attorney's Office (DAFS) to file a brief of amicus curiae in support of respondent is granted. NRAP 29. The clerk shall file the appendix received on November 6, 2017. However, we are unable to file the amended amicus brief received on November 6, 2017.1 The brief exceeds the applicable page limitation and it is unclear whether it complies with the type-volume limitation, see NRAP 29(e), because the certificate of compliance included in the brief does not state the number of words in the brief as required by NRAP 32(a)(9)(B). See NRAP 29(d) (requiring an amicus brief to comply with NRAP 32). Accordingly, DAFS shall have 5 days from the date of this order to file a certificate that complies with NRAP 32(a)(9). Failure to comply with this order may result in the rejection of the submitted amended amicus brief.
