BAR COUNSEL'S INITIAL STATUS REPORT AND REQUSET FOR EXTENSION

On November 16, 2016, this Court entered an Order Directing Status Report wherein it instructed the State Bar to, within thirty (30) days, inform this Court of Timothy Treffinger's ("Treffinger") progress in the district court's diversion program and his conduct while on probation. Bar Counsel is hereby submitting an initial status report in this matter and requesting a four (4) week extension to supplement its report.

On November 17, 2016, the State Bar contacted Treffinger and asked him to provide the name and contact information of his probation officer along with his written authorization for his probation officer to provide information sufficient for the State Bar to respond to this Court's Order. In the alternative, Treffinger was asked to contact his probation officer directly and provide a report. (Exhibit 1, November 17, 2016, letter to Treffinger)

In response to the State Bar's letter, Treffinger stated that he would obtain a status report from his probation officer and submit it as soon as possible, along with certificates

of completion of two counseling programs. (Exhibit 2, November 17, 2016, email from Treffinger)

Treffinger scheduled a meeting with his probation officer, Officer Chen, on November 23, 2016, which Officer Chen later changed to November 30, 2016. Officer Chen advised Treffinger that he could expect a report by the end of the week. When Treffinger did not receive the report, he left messages for Officer Chen on December 4 and December 8, 2016, but to date he has not received a status report. (Exhibit 3, Declaration of Timothy Treffinger).

On December 12, 2016, Treffinger provided the State Bar with Officer Chen's contact information. A State Bar Investigator called and left a message for Officer Chen to call her regarding Treffinger, as the State Bar had to respond to this Court by December 16, 2016, but the call has not been returned.

The State Bar has received no additional grievances or complaints regarding Treffinger's conduct since filing its Petition on April 12, 2016.
