The complaint also asserted that the 2 referendum petition's description of effect is inaccurate and misleading. The complaint requested 3 declaratory relief that the petition is invalid, and injunctive relief prohibiting the Secretary of State from 4 5 placing it on any ballot.

The district court entered a final order finding that the referendum petition is not a valid 6 referendum and is instead must be brought as an initiative. The district court entered declaratory relief 7 that the referendum is invalid, and issued an injunction that it shall not be placed on any ballot. 8 However, the district court stayed the injunction pending appeal to the extent that Appellant may 9 continue to collect signatures and have those signatures verified in order to determine whether the 10 referendum qualifies for the ballot. 11

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

Having read all of the pleading and papers on file herein and the relevant law applicable to the issues related to this matter as well as conducting an oral argument March 28, 2015, with all of the parties represented, the Court finds and concludes as follows:

The subject Referendum Petition proposes a substantial change to the law and not a 1. yay or nay vote on a statute or part thereof;

The subject Referendum Petition does not present a yay or nay vote on a part of a 2. statute, but rather systematic changes to various portions and words of the statute in a piecemeal approach; and

The subject Referendum Petition is not a referendum as provided for in Article 19, 3. Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution, but is actually an attempt to amend the statute which requires an initiative pursuant to Article 19, Section 2 of the Nevada Constitution.

BASED UPON the findings herein and good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the subject Referendum Petition is invalid as a referendum pursuant to Article 1. 19, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution.

That the Declaratory Relief and Injunction requested by Plaintiff is hereby 2. GRANTED in its entirety on the merits.

That the Injunction granted herein shall be stayed pending the outcome of an appeal, 3. allowing defendant, NO SOLAR TAX PAC, to obtain signatures on the Petition. Pending the outcome of an appeal of this Order, the Secretary of State and the county clerks and registrars of voters shall not be enjoined from processing the Petition to determine if the Petition has obtained enough signatures to qualify for the ballot.
