

ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion requesting that this court resolve this appeal before the deadline to print and mail ballots for overseas and military voters, which appellant asserts is “approximately August 26, 2016.” Cause appearing, we grant the motion to the extent that we will resolve this appeal as expeditiously as possible in light of the actual deadlines governing the ballots relating to this matter. We direct respondent Barbara Cegavske, Secretary of State, to file, within 5 days from the date of this order, an affidavit specifying the deadlines for the preparation, printing, and circulation of the applicable ballots.

Based on our preliminary review of the briefs and appendices, we have determined that oral argument would be of assistance in resolving the issues presented by this appeal. Accordingly, oral argument is hereby scheduled before the en banc court on July 29, 2016, at the hour of 3:00 p.m., in Las Vegas. The argument shall be limited to 60 minutes.
