*ORDER GRANTING MOTION*

This is an appeal from a district court order dismissing a complaint in an action under the UCC. On February 1, 2018, this court issued an opinion reversing the district court's order and remanding this matter to the district court for further proceedings.

On February 23, 2018, nonparty Progressive Leadership Alliance of Nevada (PLAN) filed a motion for leave to proceed as amicus curiae in this matter for the purpose of filing a motion to depublish this court's opinion. The motion is unopposed. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. *Cf.* NRAP 29. The clerk of this court shall file PLAN's motion to depublish received on February 23, 2018.<sup>1</sup>

Appellants and respondent shall each have 15 days from the date of this order to file any responses to the motion to depublish. Issuance of the remittitur shall be stayed pending further order of this court

It is so ORDERED.
