MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR REPLY BRIEF (Second Request)

Appellants hereby move for a 30-day extension for the reply brief, which is presently due on October 6, 2017. Thus, appellants request an extension until November 6, 2017. This is appellants' second requested extension for the brief.

As noted in appellants' previous motion, the answering brief includes a request for this court to dismiss the appeal, based upon jurisdictional grounds, requiring research and analysis beyond the merits of the appeal; and the answering

brief contains numerous legal authorities requiring even more extensive research and

analysis.

During the last 30 days, the undersigned counsel has completed (or nearly

completed) briefs in three other cases. Additionally, counsel presented panel oral

arguments in three different appeals during a two-week time frame in September.

All three appeals were unusual and complex cases. Counsel has another brief due

on October 9, 2017, and another oral argument before the en banc court on

November 6, 2017.

The undersigned counsel recognizes that an attorney's work load is usually

not viewed favorably as a justification for an extension. Counsel contends, however,

that his situation is exceptional, especially considering the contentions and the

unusual jurisdictional issues raised in the answering brief.

Therefore, appellants request a 30-day extension of the current deadline, until

November 6, 2017. Counsel makes this request in good faith, and without an intent

to delay the appeal unnecessarily.
