ORDER GRANTING STAY

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenging a district court order requiring production of documents. Petitioner has filed a motion to stay the underlying district court order pending this court's decision on the petition, and real parties have opposed the motion.

In determining whether to grant a stay, this court generally considers (1) whether the object of the writ petition will be defeated if the stay is denied, (2) whether petitioner will suffer irreparable or serious injury if the stay is denied, (3) whether real party in interest will suffer irreparable or serious injury if the stay is granted, and (4) whether petitioner is likely to prevail on the merits. NRAP 8(c). Having considered the motion and opposition in light of these factors, we conclude that a stay is warranted, and we therefore grant petitioner's motion. The district court's May 3, 2016, "Order Regarding (1) Motions to Compel

Freeh Documents and (2) In-Camera Review of Freeh Group Documents” shall be stayed pending further order of this court.

It is so ORDERED.
