*ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ASSOCIATE COUNSEL*

Respondent has filed a motion to associate attorneys Thomas Emerson Scott, Jr. and Scott Allan Cole of the law firm of Cole, Scott & Kissane, P.A., pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motion to associate Mr. Scott is a verified application, a certificate of good standing from the Florida Bar, and a statement pursuant to SCR 42 from the State Bar of Nevada. Attached to the motion to associate Mr. Cole is a verified application, a certificate of good standing from the Florida Bar, and a statement pursuant to SCR 42 from the State Bar of Nevada. The State Bar of Nevada's Rule 42 statements indicate that neither Mr. Scott, nor Mr. Cole has applied to appear in Nevada courts within the past 3 years. See SCR 42(6) (stating that repeated appearances by any person pursuant to this rule shall be cause for denial of the motion). Accordingly, we grant the motion to associate. SCR 42(8). Mr. Scott and Mr. Cole shall be permitted to appear on behalf of respondent in this matter. Nevada attorney Matthew J. Douglas of Atkin Winner & Sherrod shall be responsible for all matters presented by Mr. Scott and Mr. Cole in this appeal. See SCR 42(14)(a) (requiring the Nevada attorney of record to be

responsible for and actively participate in the representation of a client in these proceedings); NRAP 25(a)(5) (requiring all documents submitted to the supreme court for filing to include the original signature of at least one attorney of record who is an active member of the State Bar of Nevada); NRAP 46(a)(3) (requiring Nevada counsel to sign all briefs, be present during oral argument, and be responsible for all briefs and matters presented by foreign counsel).

It is so ORDERED.
