ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ASSOCIATE COUNSEL

Appellants have filed a motion and amended motion to associate attorney Mark A. Boyle of Boyle & Leonard, P.A. pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motion to associate Mr. Boyle is a verified application, certificate of good standing from the state of Florida, and a statement pursuant to SCR 42 from the State Bar of Nevada. The State Bar of Nevada's Rule 42 statement indicates that Mr. Boyle has not applied to appear in Nevada courts within the past 3 years, *see* SCR 42(6) (stating that repeated appearances by any person or firm pursuant to this rule shall be cause for denial of the motion).

Cause appearing, we grant the motion to associate. SCR 42(8). Mr. Boyle shall be permitted to appear on behalf of appellants in this matter. Nevada attorney David T. Pursiano of Pursiano Barry Bruce Lavelle, LLP shall be responsible for all matters presented by Mr. Boyle in this appeal. *See* SCR 42(14) (requiring the Nevada attorney of record to be responsible for and actively participate in the representation of a client in these proceedings, and to be present at all matters in open court); NRAP 25(a)(5) (requiring all documents submitted to the supreme court for filing to include the original signature of at least one attorney of record who is

an active member of the State Bar of Nevada); NRAP 46(a)(3) (requiring Nevada counsel to sign all briefs, be present during oral argument, and be responsible for all briefs and matters presented by foreign counsel).

It is so ORDERED.
