**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL OPENING
BRIEF REGARDING SECOND CERTIFIED QUESTION OF LAW**

Appellants JAMES NALDER, Guardian Ad Litem on behalf of CHEYANNE NALDER and GARY LEWIS, individually respectfully request an extension of thirty-nine days, up to and including July 1, 2018, to file their Supplemental Opening Brief Regarding Second Certified Question of Law. This is the first such motion Appellants have filed. On March 22, 2018, the parties filed their first Stipulation for Extension of Time to File Supplemental Opening Brief Regarding Second Certified Question of Law pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(2). Appellants have not sought any other prior extensions and this Court has not denied or denied, in part, any requests for extensions of time in this case. Counsel's preparation for these matters has been extensive given the importance of the legal issues he will address before this Court. Additional time will ensure that counsel is able to adequately address the unique certified question of law that is currently before this Court in this case. This request is not meant to prejudice Respondent or cause undue delay.
