ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Extraordinary circumstances and extreme need having been shown, respondent's motion requesting a second extension of time to file the supplemental answering brief regarding the second certified question of law is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Respondent shall have until November 19, 2018, to file and serve the supplemental answering brief. Any additional extensions will be granted only on showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. *Id.* Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the supplemental answering brief may result in the imposition of sanctions.
