## SUMMARY

Sergeant Donald Hoier has been a police officer with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department for twenty (21) years. The first nine (9) years of his career were spent in the Patrol Division, where he served as a first responder. During this time period, he served for two (2) years as a Field Training Officer - responsible for mentoring, training and evaluating newly graduated Police Officers; became a Nevada POST certified Defensive Tactics Instructor; and served for a year as a Field Training Sergeant – responsible for supervising, mentoring, training and evaluating a squad of Field Training Officers and their newly graduated trainees. He was promoted to his current rank on February 28, 1998.

Sergeant Hoier transferred to the Vice Section, Vice/Narcotics Bureau in 2001. His vice experience and training spans nearly twelve (12) years, and includes operations in the areas of enforcement, investigations and intelligence gathering involving pimps, prostitutes, their clientele, and others in the illegal adult entertainment/sex industry. Sergeant Hoier currently supervises the Pandering Investigations Team (PIT), which is responsible for identifying, targeting and apprehending individuals involved in pandering-related crimes and the Trick Roll Investigative Cases Team (TRIC), which is responsible for investigating vice-related theft. He has been involved in hundreds of pandering investigations, involving both juvenile and adult victims of prostitution, and has conducted thousands of hours of interviews with pimps, prostitutes and their clientele. Sergeant Hoier continues to expand his knowledge of the pimp/prostitute subculture, vice-related issues, and the adult entertainment/sex industry through independent study, to include: the reading of books, specialized publications and research papers; viewing related documentaries; internet research; and by attending related seminars and conferences. This has given him a unique insight to and understanding of the pimp/prostitute subculture and sex industry, to include its language, customs, rules, regulations, networks, operational strategies, methods of recruitment and discipline.

While assigned to the Vice Section, Sergeant Hoier has, and continues to, develop and provide vice-related training to law enforcement and security professionals throughout Clark County, Nevada. He assisted in the development of, and currently instructs, the pimp/prostitute subculture portions of the First Offender Prostitution Program and Female Prostitution Diversion Program offered by the Las Vegas Municipal Court Alternative Sentencing Division. In 2005, Dr. Dimitri Shalin, Director of the UNLV Center for Democratic Culture, contacted the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department seeking input to and review of the "Sex Industry and Sex Workers" chapter of <u>The Social Health of Nevada Report</u>, prior to it being forwarded on to Governor Guinn. Sergeant Hoier was selected to represent the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department in this endeavor.

Sergeant Hoier has testified multiple times in the 8<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, Clark County Justice Court, and Las Vegas Municipal Court trials regarding vice-related cases, including pandering-related crimes.
