THE DEFENDANT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED guilty of said offenses and, in addition to the \$25.00 Administrative Assessment Fee, \$250.00 Indigent Defense Civil Assessment Fee, and a \$150.00 DNA Analysis Fee including testing to determine genetic markers, plus a \$3.00 DNA Collection Fee, the Defendant is sentenced as follows: As to COUNT 2 - TO LIFE with a possibility of parole after a term of TEN (10) YEARS have been served in the Nevada Department of Corrections (NDC); with EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-ONE (841) days Credit for Time Served. As to COUNTS 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7,8, 9, 10, 11 & 12, Defendant found NOT GUILTY.
