DECLARATION OF BRENT D. PERCIVAL IN SUPPORT OF REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE OPENING BRIEF AND APPENDIX

BRENT D. PERCIVAL, knowing the penalties for perjury, does state the following under penalty of perjury:

1. I am attorney licensed to practice in the state of Nevada, before the U.S. District Courts in and for the States of Nevada and Kansas. I have been so licensed within the State of Nevada since approximately November 18, 1988.

2. I was appointed to represent Defendant/Appellant DVONTAE RICHARD in the Eighth Judicial District Court.

3. This is an appeal following a five day trial. After the conclusion of trial evidence presentation, Mr. RICHARD was convicted of committing ten (10) crimes: 2 counts of conspiracy to commit robbery, burglary while in possession of a firearm, grand larceny of firearm, grand larceny, robbery with use of a deadly weapon, battery with intent to commit a crime, and ownership or possession of firearm by prohibited person.

4. On May 25, 2016, the district court imposed sentences on the ten convictions which resulted in an aggregate minimum of sixteen (16) years and an aggregate maximum of sixty-one (61) years of incarceration in the Nevada Department of Corrections.

5. The primary issue raised in this appeal challenges the district court's determination that Mr. RICHARD: (1) was informed of his Miranda rights prior to being questioned by Las Vegas Metropolitan Police officers; and, (2) that the custodial interrogations were involuntary.

6. While finalizing the four (4) volume Appendix, I realized that copies of Mr. RICHARD's two (2) statements were not part of the record. I ordered copies of the statements from the District Court evidence vault which were obtained today.

7. Addition of these exhibits required re-pagination of the appendix and re-division of the four (4) volumes of the appendix.

8. Addition of these exhibits to the appendix required an update of all of the citations to the record in the opening brief.

I have not been able to complete the update of all of the citations to the record and I respectfully request this Honorable Court grant me an additional five (5) days to file the opening brief and appeal.
