Local 14 is also a respondent before this Court and therefore may file an answering brief. *See* Nev. R. App. P. 28(b). Local 14's brief will support the EMRB's position that the district court improperly granted the petition for judicial review. Therefore, Local 14 seeks permission to file opening and reply briefs at the same time as Appellant EMRB. Local 14 anticipates that it will join in all or part of the EMRB's briefs. This alteration of the ordinary briefing rule will be more economical and will allow Education Support Employees Association the opportunity to respond to any arguments that Local 14 makes in support of the administrative decision.

For all of the foregoing reasons, Local 14 requests leave to file opening and reply briefs before this Court.
