O R D E R

This appeal is subject to the provisions of Nevada Rule of Appellate Procedure 3C. On August 29, 2001, counsel for appellant filed a motion to amend the fast track statement. Attached to the motion is a proper person motion from appellant asking for leave to supplement the fast track statement. Counsel for appellant seeks leave to amend the fast track statement by supplementing the fast track statement with appellant's proper person document. NRAP 3C(i) provides, in part, that motions to amend fast track responses "shall be granted only upon demonstration of extreme need or merit." Appellant has failed to demonstrate extreme need or merit, and the motion is therefore denied.
